ACTIVITIES:- Conference facilities; Receptions; Club or other group meetings; Recorded music; Live performances; Dance facilities; indoor/outdoor sports; outdoor drinking facilities; training events; fitness classes and yoga.

CHILDREN AND YOUNG PERSONS CONDITIONS:-

TERMS – Children and young persons of all ages will be allowed access in the company of a person aged 18 years or over for the purpose of participation in bowling games and to attend any family functions.

AGES – Children of all ages (birth to 15 years) and young persons (16 and 17 years).

TIMES – Access allowed to clubhouse and outdoor drinking area until 8.00pm unless attending a family function when access will be for the duration of the function.

PARTS – All public areas of the premises including main function hall, outdoor drinking area and toilets.

CAPACITY OF PREMISES:- On sales – 110 persons.

LSO COMMENTS: This is a new premises licence application to allow the Club to sell alcohol on a permanent basis to members and guests of members. The Club has previously licensed the premises via occasional licences and there has been no problems or concerns raised.

Description of Premises

The following is the description of the premises agreed with the Club Committee and which should appear on the front page of the premises licence –

“Detached Clubhouse in its own grounds. Principally a hall, with toilets, kitchen, small bar and outdoor drinking area.”

Activities

In addition to bowling club activities, the premises may be used for conferences; training events and fitness classes, such as yoga, and may open prior to core hours. No alcohol will be available prior to core hours.

Outdoor Drinking

The applicant proposes outdoor drinking as depicted on the proposed layout plan, which is the area overlooking the Cub bowling green. The Board may wish to impose the usual terminal hour for outdoor drinking of 10:00pm for persons aged 18 years and over and 8:00pm for children and young persons.

Children and Young Persons Access

The applicant is proposing that children and young persons be allowed access to the premises in the company of a person aged 18 years and over for the purpose of club activities and attending family functions. This is in keeping with Board policy.

Capacity

The applicant proposes a capacity of 110 persons.

Designated Premises Manager Details

As this is a Club run under the requirements of The Licensing (Clubs) (Scotland) Regulations 2007, the premises are exempt from naming a premises manager for the premises.
