Home deliveries may be provided to customers. Alcohol will only be delivered in terms of and in compliance with the relevant provisions of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

LSO COMMENTS: An application to add home delivery of alcohol to question 5 (f) of the operating plan, *any other activities*. The LSO can monitor home delivery of alcohol as part of the overall inspection programme.
