Elderly care – supported accommodation and care	 need respite and supported facilities – especially as the population is ageing
Leisure facilities for children and families	 facilities in schools could be used more more variety would be could – e.g. travelling arts and sports events
Adult education	 scope and provision not enough to meet demand

Childcare services	 demand on Islay and Colonsay – no demand on Jura long waiting lists – few registered childminders access is biggest concern, rather than quality
