Activity - Make your own Gruffalo masks

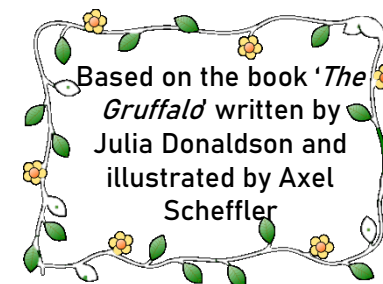
Safety: supervise your child when using scissors and teach them basic safety rules for using and storing them.
