National Lottery Community Fund to Close Three Funding Programmes in August 2024

The National Lottery Community Fund has announced that it will launch new funding programmes for Scotland later in 2024. As a result, it will close the following funding programmes from August 2024:

- Community-led Activity - grants of between £20,001 and £150,000 for projects in local communities within Scotland that bring real improvement to the places where people live and to those in need.
- Improving Lives - grants of between £20,001 and £200,000 for activities to help people in Scotland overcome difficulties and become more resilient.
- Cost-of Living Support Scotland - grants of between £20,001 and £75,000 for projects to support individuals, families and communities currently experiencing hardship as a result of the cost-of-living crisis.

The National Lottery Awards for All, Young Start and the Scottish Land Fund will all remain open as normal.

We will continue to promote the funds until the **Deadline 21 August 2024**

Community Ownership Fund Accepting Expressions of Interest for Final Round

The Government has announced that ahead of the launch of the fourth and final round of the £150 million Community Ownership Fund (COF), it has published a new Expression of Interest (EOI) form. Only applicants who submitted an EOI in the new system will be informed when a bidding window is about to open and will receive the link needed to apply to the fund.
