
NOTICE TO MARINERS No.05/24

Campbeltown 13.05.24

Mariners are advised that Royal Navy whilst exercising at the entrance and approaches to Campbeltown Loch have lost a bright yellow ROV (approx. dimensions 70cmx40cm) which became snagged on an underwater obstruction in approximate position 55 26.413'N 005 31.543'W at a depth of 47.0m. The ROV is buoyant and has the potential to float free and drift low in the water creating the risk of collision. Mariners are therefore requested to navigate and manoeuvre with caution when transiting Campbeltown Loch and its approaches and navigational channel.
