

**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(DUNOON TOWN CENTRE)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024**

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and being of the opinion that it is desirable because of public safety and convenience, hereby make the following order:

1. This Order may be cited as the "Argyll and Bute Council (Dunoon Town Centre) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2024".
2. This Order shall be in operation when indicated by signs from 1700 hours to 2324 hours on Friday the Twenty First day of June 2024 (Duration of this Order).
3. Item 1 in Schedule 7 of The Strathclyde Regional Council (Dunoon Town Centre) (Traffic Management) Order 1996 will be temporarily suspended for the duration of this Order, to permit two-way traffic in Clyde Street, Jane Street and Park Avenue.
4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length of road as specified in the Schedule to this order and for the Duration of this Order.
5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle which is:
 - a) being driven under the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, or an event official;
 - b) an emergency services vehicle;
 - c) a bus or authorised vehicle requiring access to the ferry terminal from the north of the closure via the A815 Alexandra Parade/Pier Esplanade.
