THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (B8001 CLOANAIG) (TEMPORARY 10MPH SPEED RESTRICTION)(No.2) ORDER 2024

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, hereby make the following Order:

- This Order may be cited as "The Argyll and Bute Council (B8001 Cloanaig) (Temporary 10mph Speed Restriction) (No.2) Order 2024" and will be effective, when indicated by signs, from 2359 hours on 25th July 2024 until 2359 hours on 7th September 2025 or until the works are complete, whichever is the earliest.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 10mph, on that length of that length of the B8001 Cloanaig from a point 130 metres south east of its junction with the B842 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 250 metres or thereby.
