ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (BUNNAHABHAIN ROAD, ISLAY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), and having complied with the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and being satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto should be prohibited or restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road hereby make the following Order:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the "Argyll and Bute Council (Bunnahabhain Road, Islay)(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024" and will be effective, when indicated by signs, from of 0001 hours on Fifth day of August 2024 until 2359 hours on Thirty First day of October 2024, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Prohibition of traffic

3. Save as provided for in Article 4, no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on the length of road as specified in the Schedule to this order.

Exemptions

4. No prohibition imposed by this Order will apply to (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire and rescue services, ambulance or police purposes, (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works, or (c) a vehicle requiring access/egress to and from affected properties when possible and as directed by traffic management operatives on site.
