Community Consultation

Hello and welcome to the initial consultation document for the local community, residents and stakeholders in relation to the 2025 Dunoon Presents Argyll Rally.

The 2025 Argyll Rally will be held on Friday 20th and Saturday 21st June 2025 based at the Dunoon Stadium with closed road Special Stages* held in Dunoon town centre and on the rural roads around the Cowal Peninsula. The event will be held under *The Motor Sport on Public Roads (Scotland) Regulations 2019* which allows public roads to be closed for the purposes of motor sport following consultation and approval by Motorsport UK and Argyll and Bute Council.

This document is designed to provide initial details of the planned route for the 2025 Argyll Rally to all those that may be affected by the event and the resultant road closures, and to seek the views of all stakeholders prior to any plans being finalised. Within this document are maps showing what roads will be closed along with the times of the closures over the two days of the rally. The roads shown in red on each map indicate section of road will be closed, and each section has a stage reference number (e.g. SS1) and a stage name (e.g. Dunoon)

The Argyll Rally has run as a closed road tarmac rally on an annual basis since 2021. The route for 2025 is similar to the 2024 route, however there are a few significant changes. The proposed route utilises two new sections of road for the first time, these are the southern half of the B8000 from its junction with the C11 (north of Otter Ferry) to the village of Kilfinan, and a three mile section of road from South of Millhouse to just beyond the junction for Ardlamont Point. The are shown as *SS13 – Kilfinan* and *SS14 – Millhouse* on the maps below.

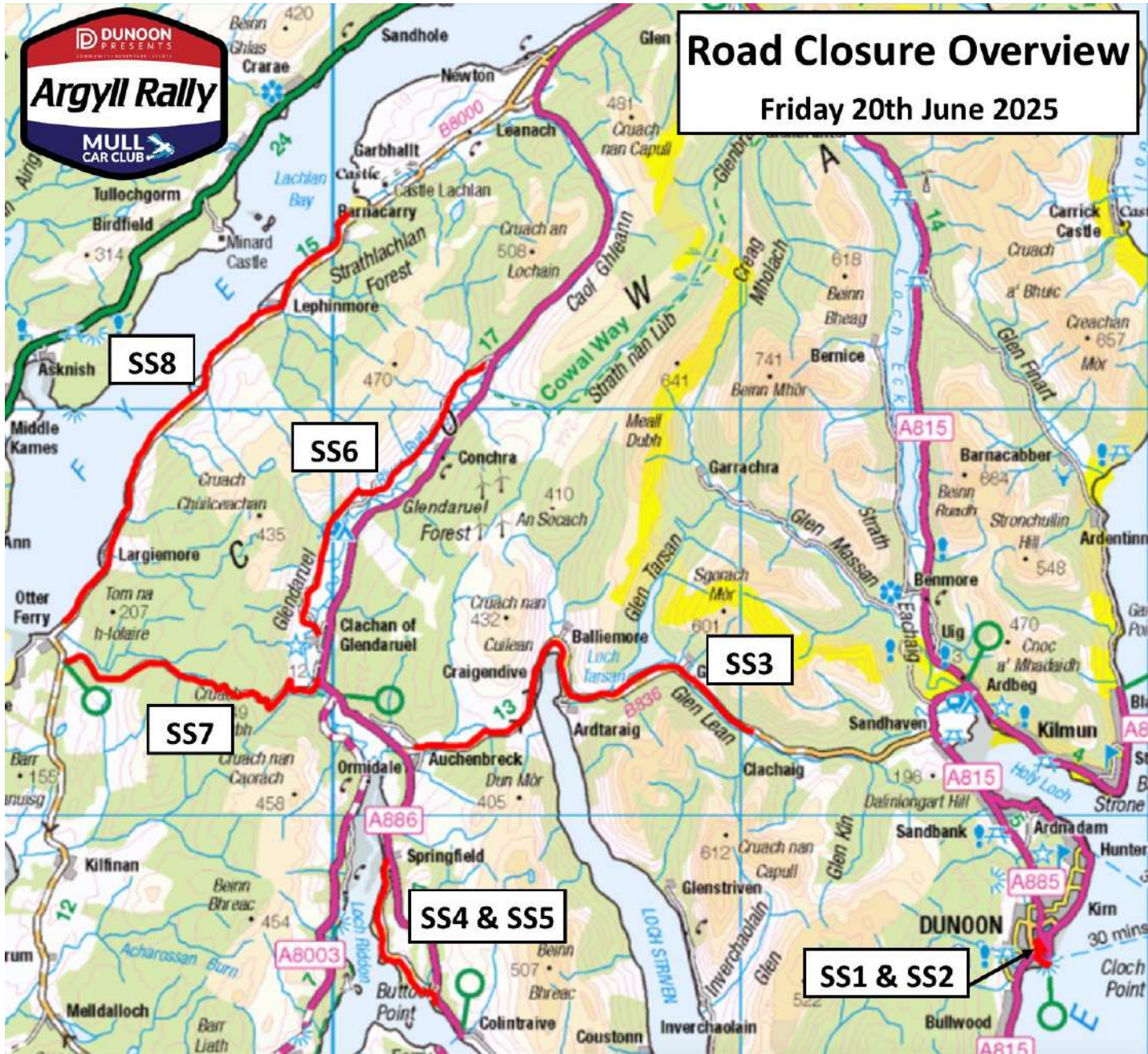

"Road Opens" times are always a latest time. Wherever possible roads will be opened prior to these times.

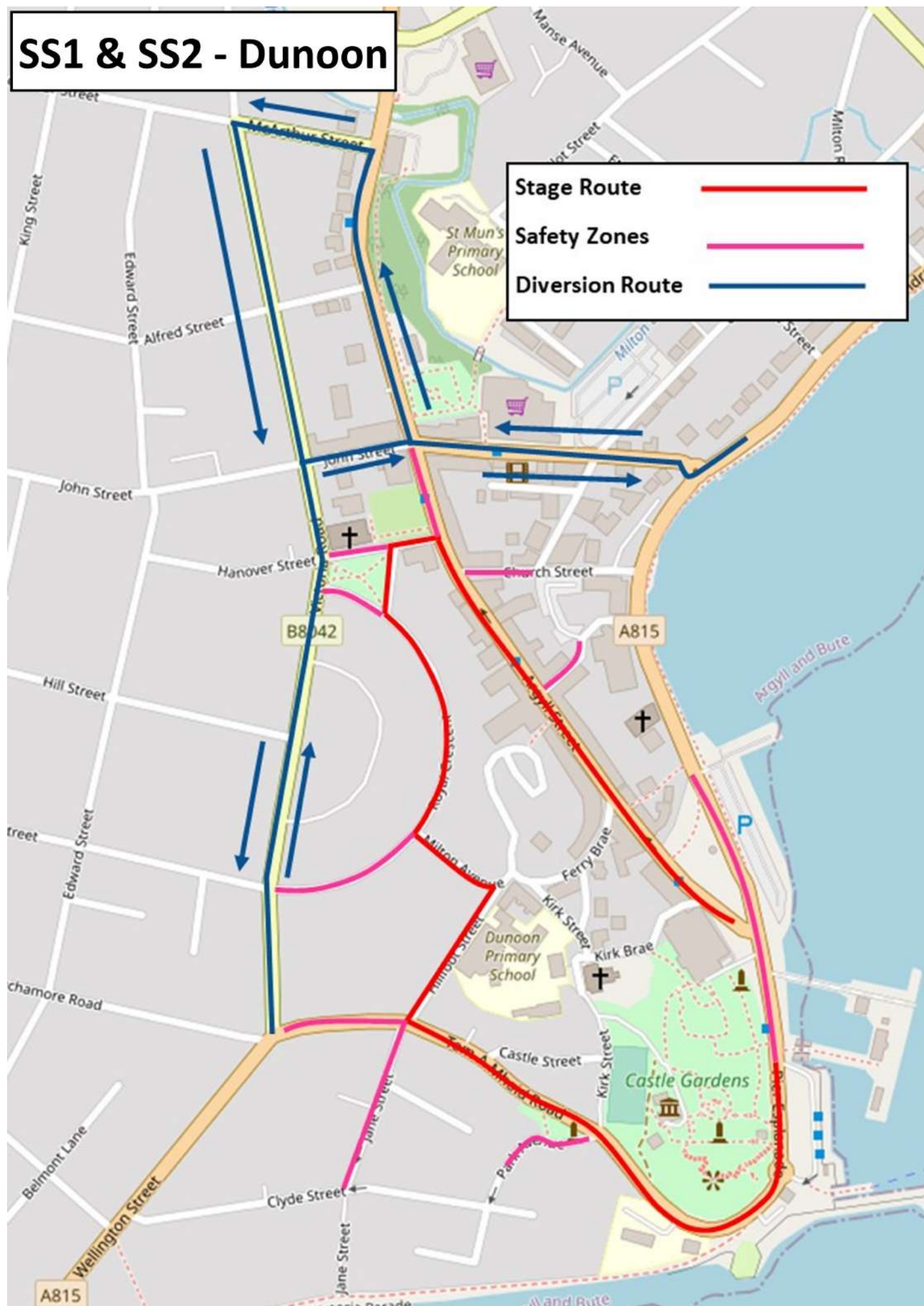


Road Closure Overview

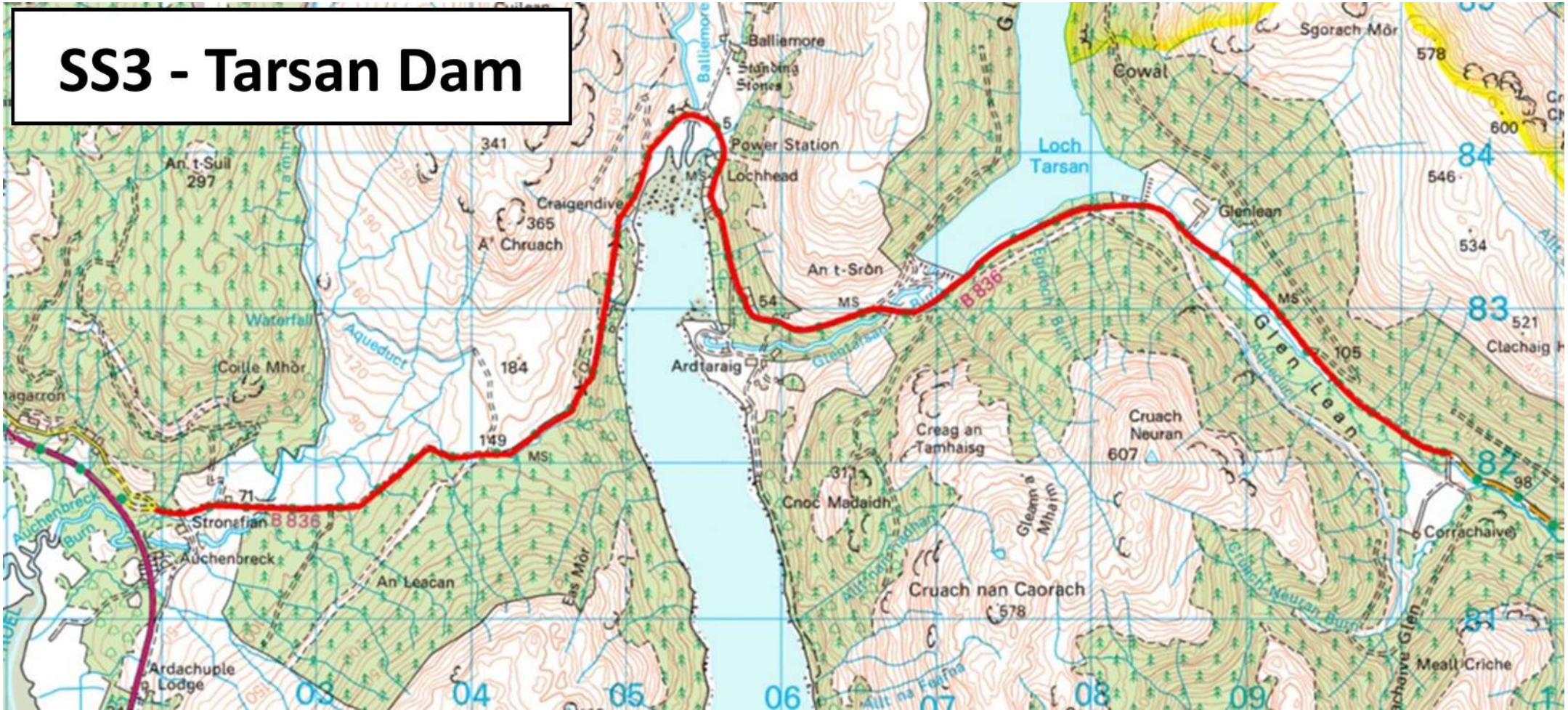

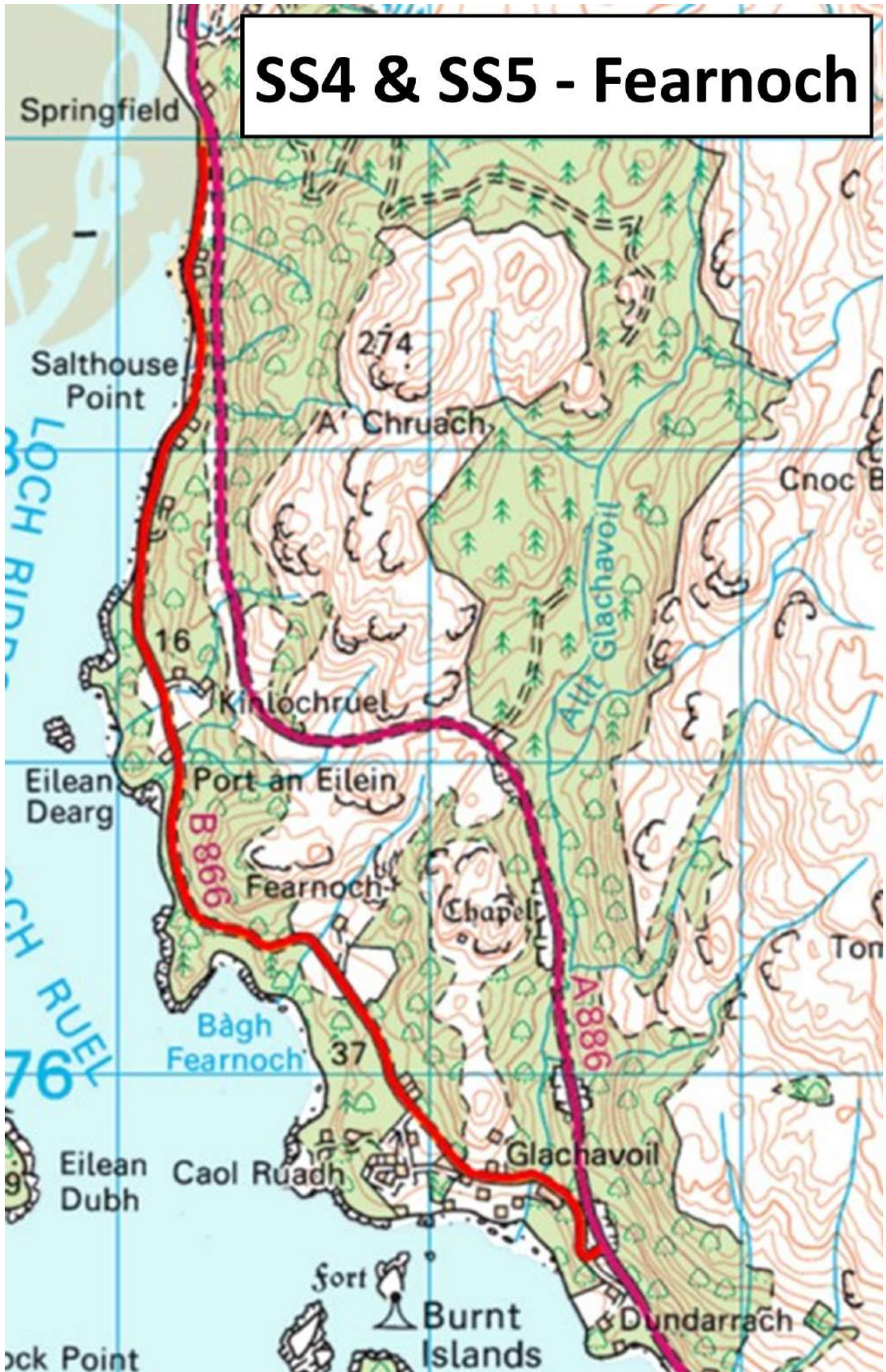
SS1 & SS2 - Dunoon



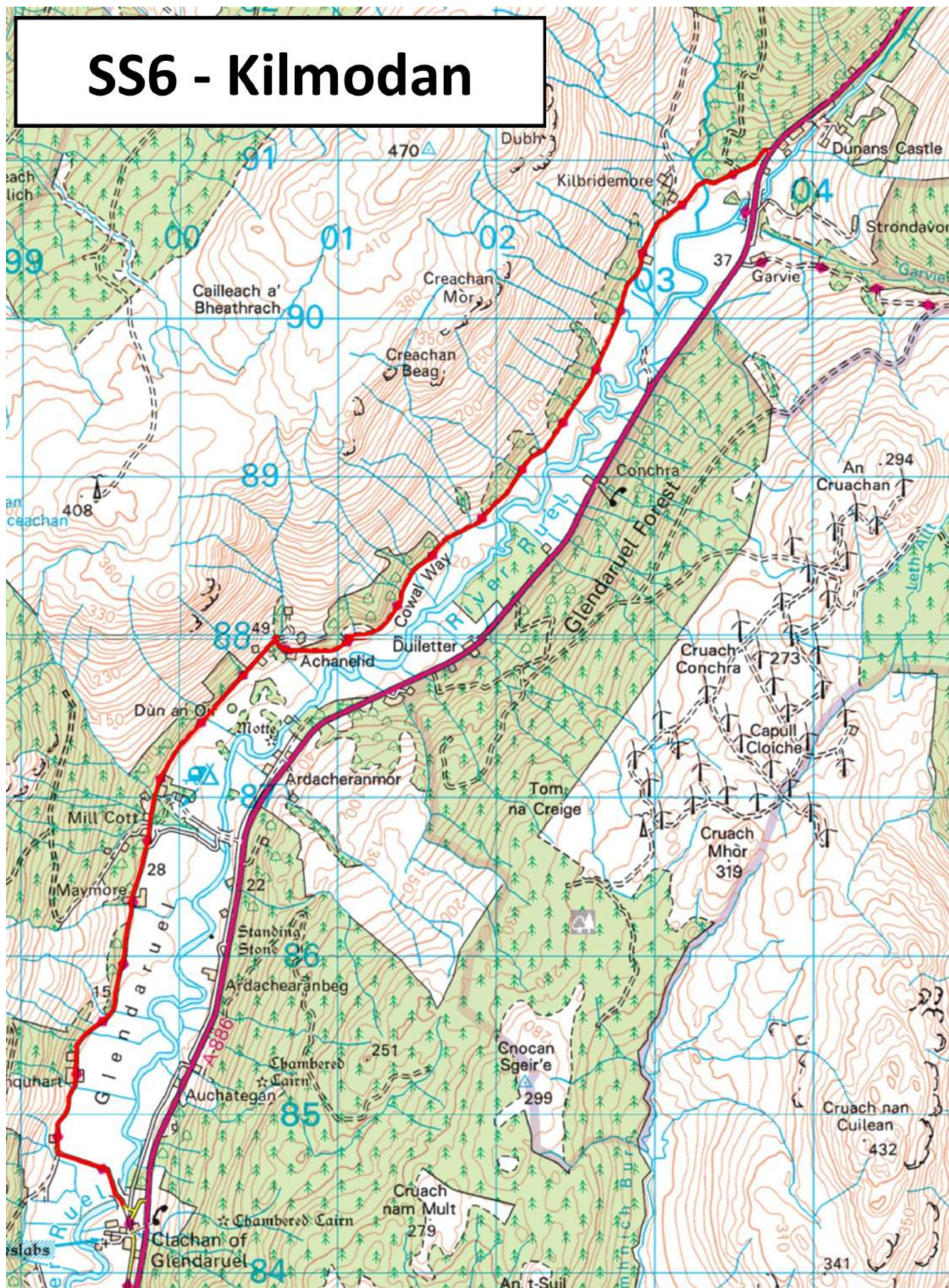
SS3 - Tarsan Dam



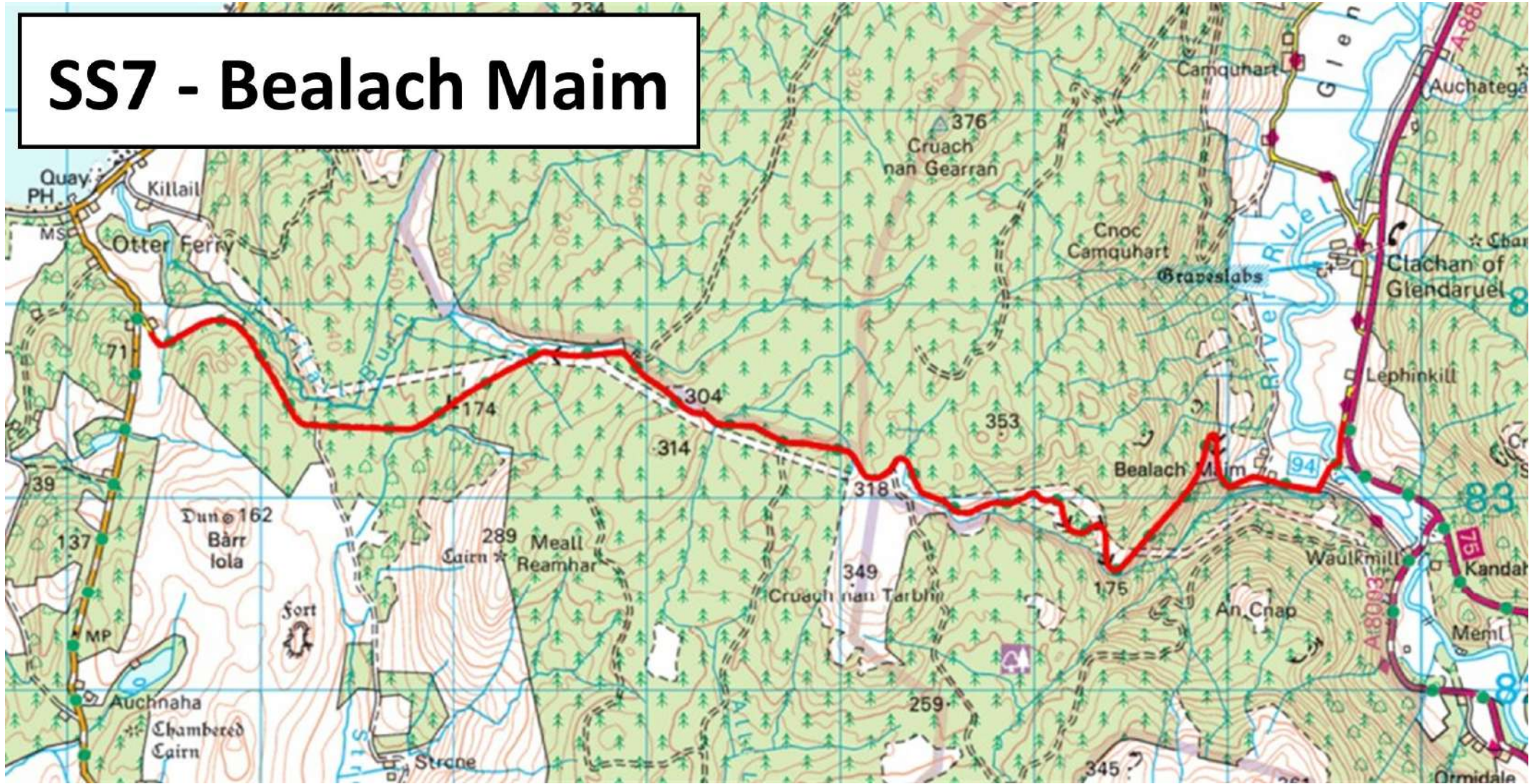
SS4 & SS5 - Fearnoch



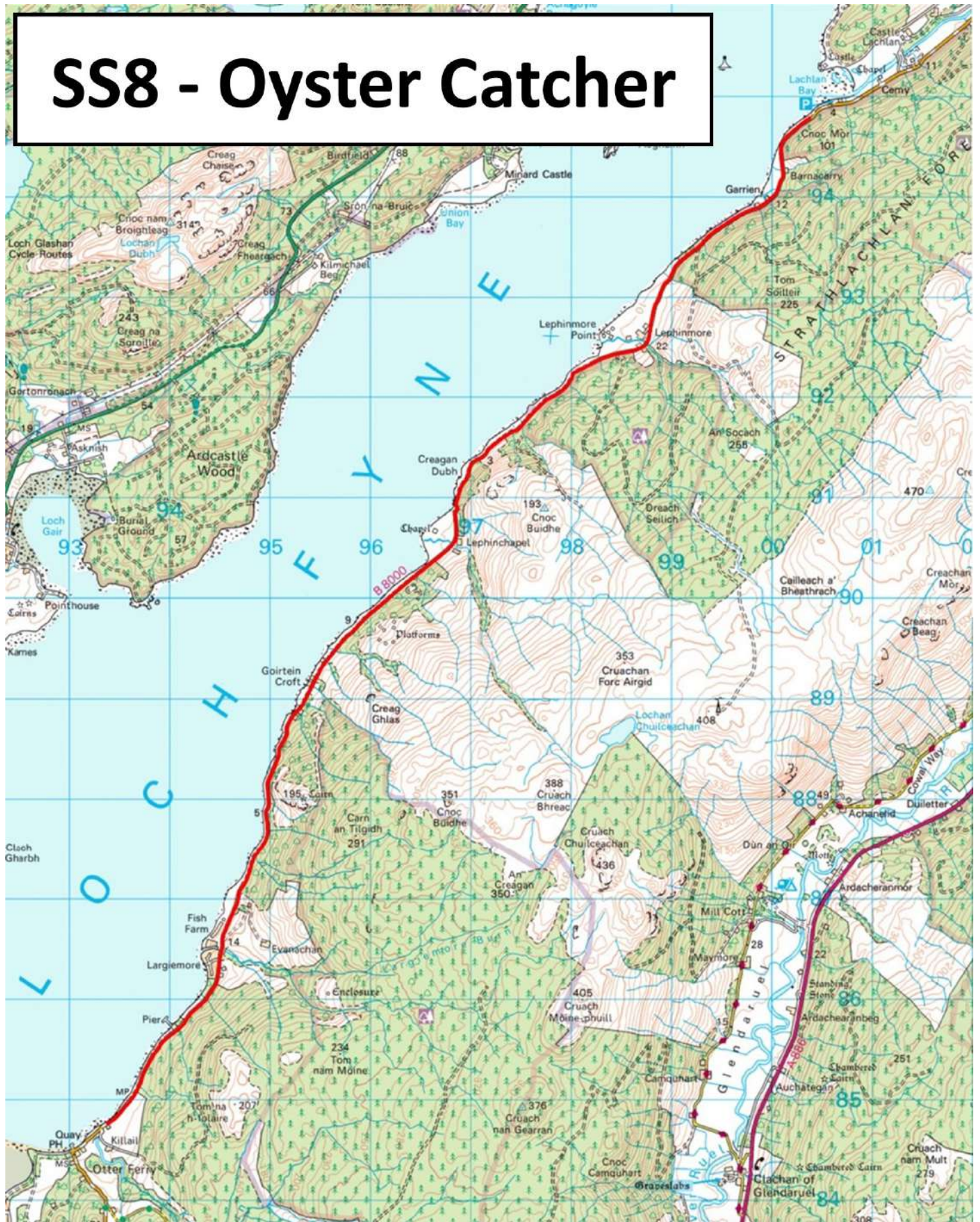

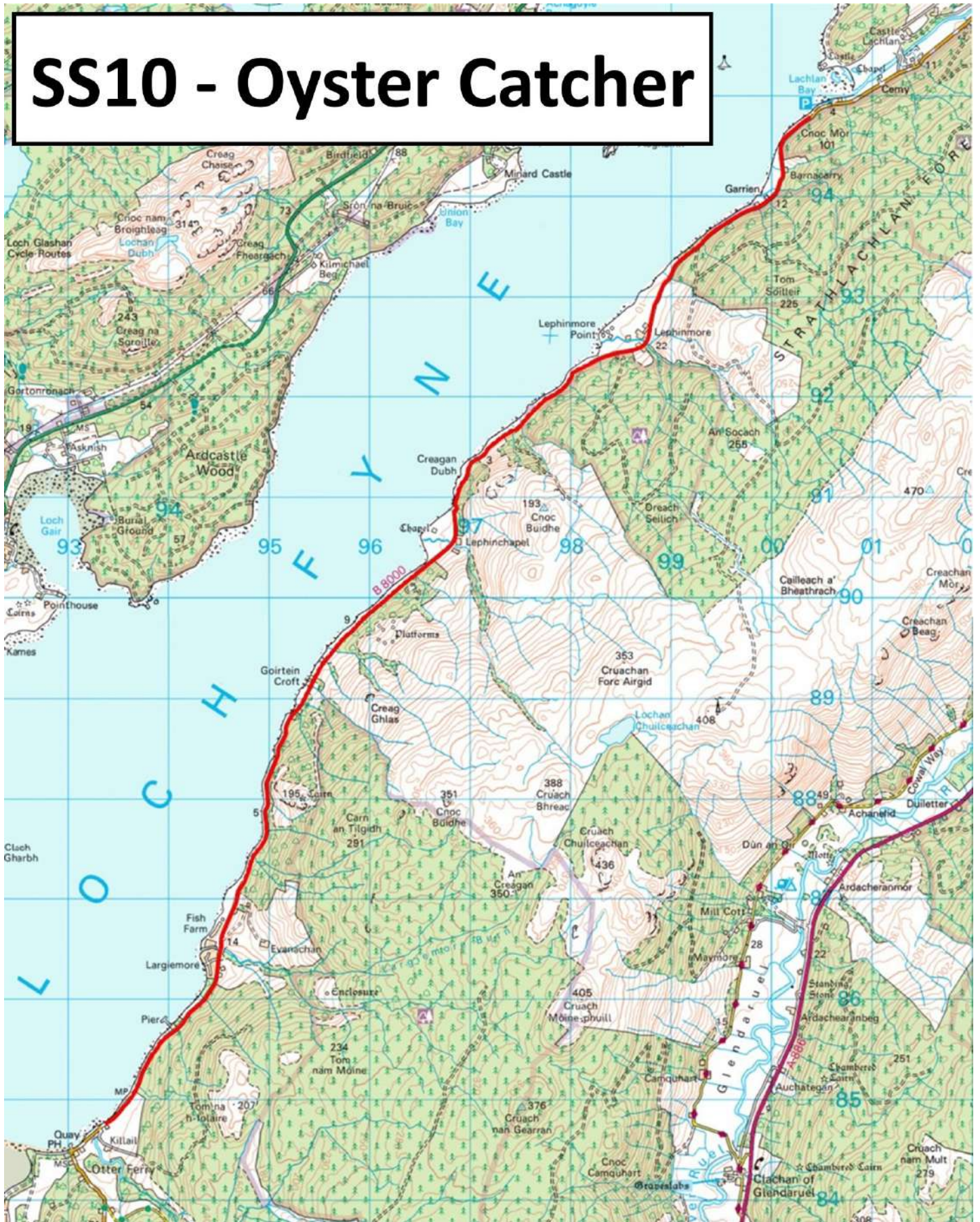

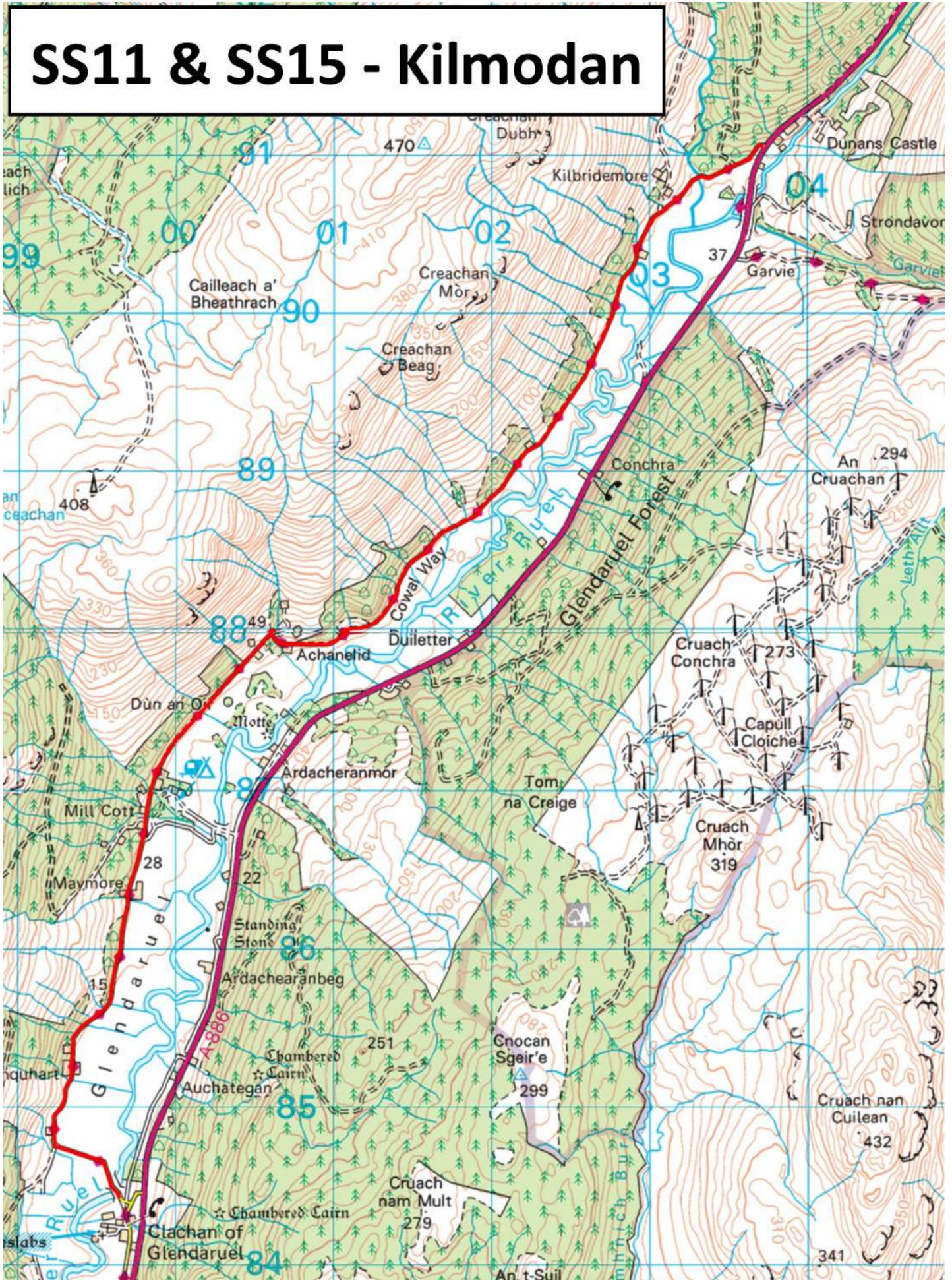

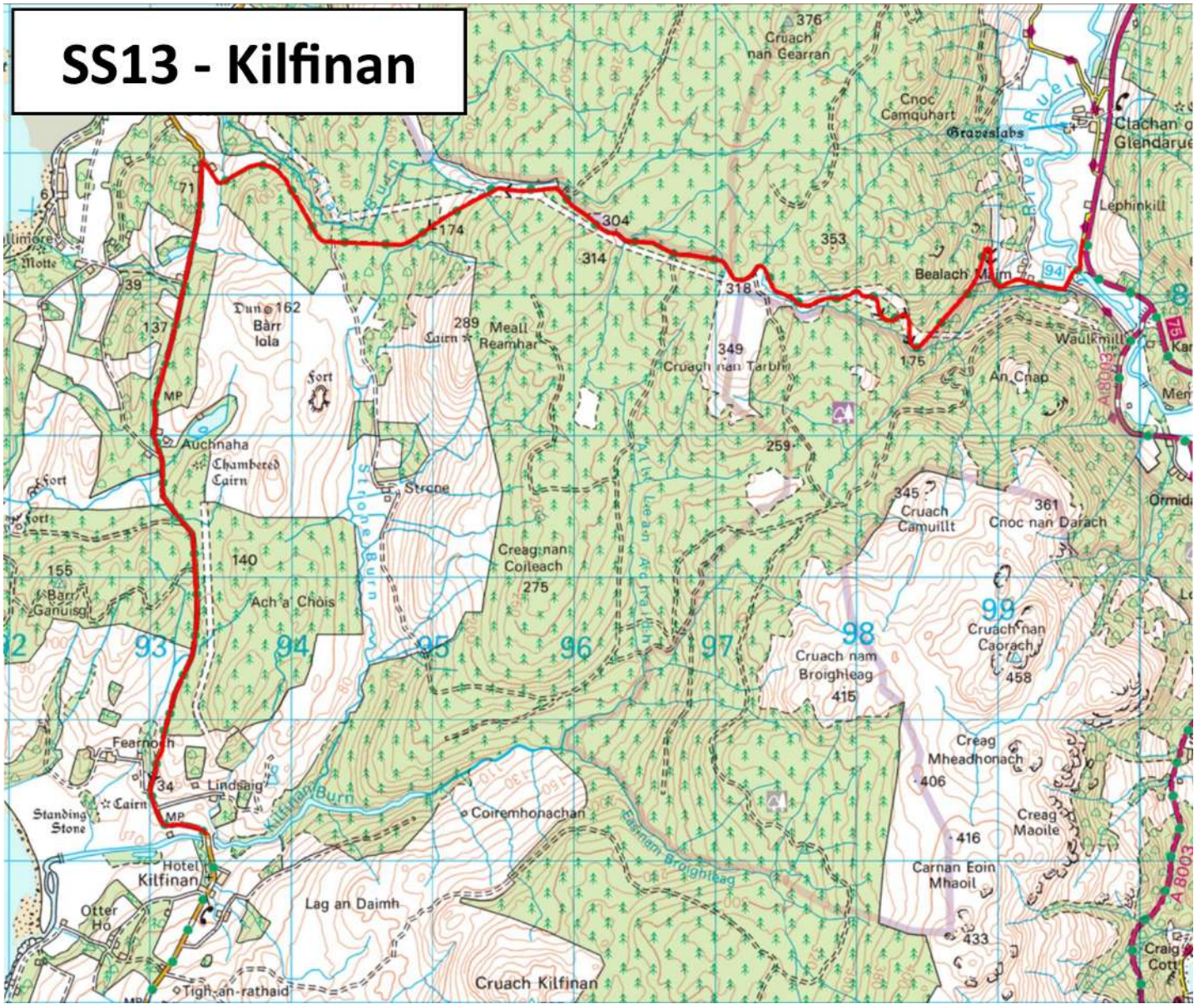
