(A847 PORT CHARLOTTE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING)  
ORDER 2024**



On Thursday the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

### **SCHEDULE PROHIBITION OF WAITING**

<b><u>Length of Road within Port Charlotte</u></b>	<b><u>Side of road to which restriction applies</u></b>
<b><u>A847</u></b>	
1. From speed limit signs adjacent to Port Mor Centre in a north westerly direction to a point 50 metres south west of the speed limit signs for a distance of 1.4 kilometres or thereby.	Both

Exceptions will apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes. The restrictions imposed by this Order which are required to help facilitate the works required on or near the road and will be effective when indicated by signs from 0001 on the Second Day of September 2024 to 2359 on the Eighteenth day of October 2024, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier.
