ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (SHORE STREET, CAMPBELTOWN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)(No.2) ORDER 2024

On Thursday 15th August 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on that length of Shore Street, from its junction with the B842 Main Street in a easterly direction to its junction with St John Street for a distance of 140 metres or thereby.

The restrictions imposed by this Order which are required because essential works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road will be effective, when indicated by signs, from of 0001 hours on Twenty Sixth day of August 2024 until 2359 hours on Twenty Seventh day of September 2024, or until the works are complete, whichever is the earlier. Exceptions will apply to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.
