THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES AND CHARGES) (HELENSBURGH) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2024



On Wednesday 18th September 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Order which can be implemented from Monday 4th November 2024, will not be implemented until such time as appropriate signs and devices are installed. This will be supported through a communications package through December with a view to enforcement commencing in January 2025.

The amendments to the existing Off Street Parking Places and Charges, Helensburgh introduces new and make amendments to the some of the existing parking restrictions in Helensburgh for the following reasons:-

- Manage the available provision of parking places.
- Reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking
- Help patrons of the Waterfront Development to use the facilities.
- Improve road safety.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may by 21st October 2024, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
