

Is your organisation a Community Transfer Body?

The following checklist may help you understand if you qualify as a "Community Transfer Body" enabling you to make an asset transfer request.

Your organisations constitution or governing documents must contain the following provisions detailed below.

When you can show that all of the above are detailed in your governing documents you will be able to be designated a Community Transfer Body and we would be able the review any Asset Transfer Request

If your organisation is planning to request full transfer of ownership there are additional provisions that need to be detailed in your governing documents
