(40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 202_**

Argyll and Bute Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 84(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other powers enabling them to do so, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, and having complied with Part II of the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby make the following Order:

- 1 This Order may be cited as “The Argyll and Bute Council (Route B843 Machrihanish Road, Kintyre) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 201_” and shall come into operation on Monday the ___ day of __ Two Thousand and ___.
- 2 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3 No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

40MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length of Road in Argyll and Bute

That length of the Route B843 Machrihanish Road, from a point 1045 metres or thereby east of the extended west kerbline of the Isleview Housing Scheme Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 620 metres or thereby.
