**ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(STAFFORD STREET, OBAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)
ORDER 2024**

On Thursday 24th October 2024, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will make it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on that length of Stafford Street (adjacent to Oban Distillery), which extends from its junction with George Street (A85 Trunk Road), in an easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres or thereby. Exceptions will apply to any vehicle which is being driven upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform; or being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

The restrictions which are required to facilitate the Oban Winter Festival Event shall be effective when indicated by signs, between 0800 hours and 1600 hours on Saturday the Sixteenth Day of November, Saturday the Twenty Third Day of November and Sunday the Twenty Fourth day of November, Two Thousand and Twenty Four.
