


**THE ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL
(A814 ALDER GATE, HELENSBURGH)
(30MPH SPEED LIMIT AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2024**

Argyll and Bute Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 84(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ('the Act'), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, and having complied with Part II of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1999, hereby make the following Order:

This Order may be cited as "The Argyll and Bute Council (A814 Alder Gate, Helensburgh) (30mph Speed Limit And 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2024" and shall come into operation on Monday the Thirtieth Day of December Two Thousand and Twenty Four.

- 1 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 2 No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

30MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length of Road in Argyll and Bute

That length of the Dumbarton-Arrochar Road (Route A814), within the town of Helensburgh, from a point 305 metres south easterly of the extended east kerb line of the entrance road to Hermitage Academy in a south easterly direction to a point 5 metres west of the extended west kerb line of the entrance road to the property known as Iona Stable for a distance of 240 metres or thereby.

40MPH SPEED LIMIT

Length of Road in Argyll and Bute

That length of the Dumbarton-Arrochar Road (Route A814), within the town of Helensburgh, from a point 5 metres west of the extended west kerb line of the entrance road to the property known as Iona Stable in a south easterly direction for a distance of 420 metres or thereby.
