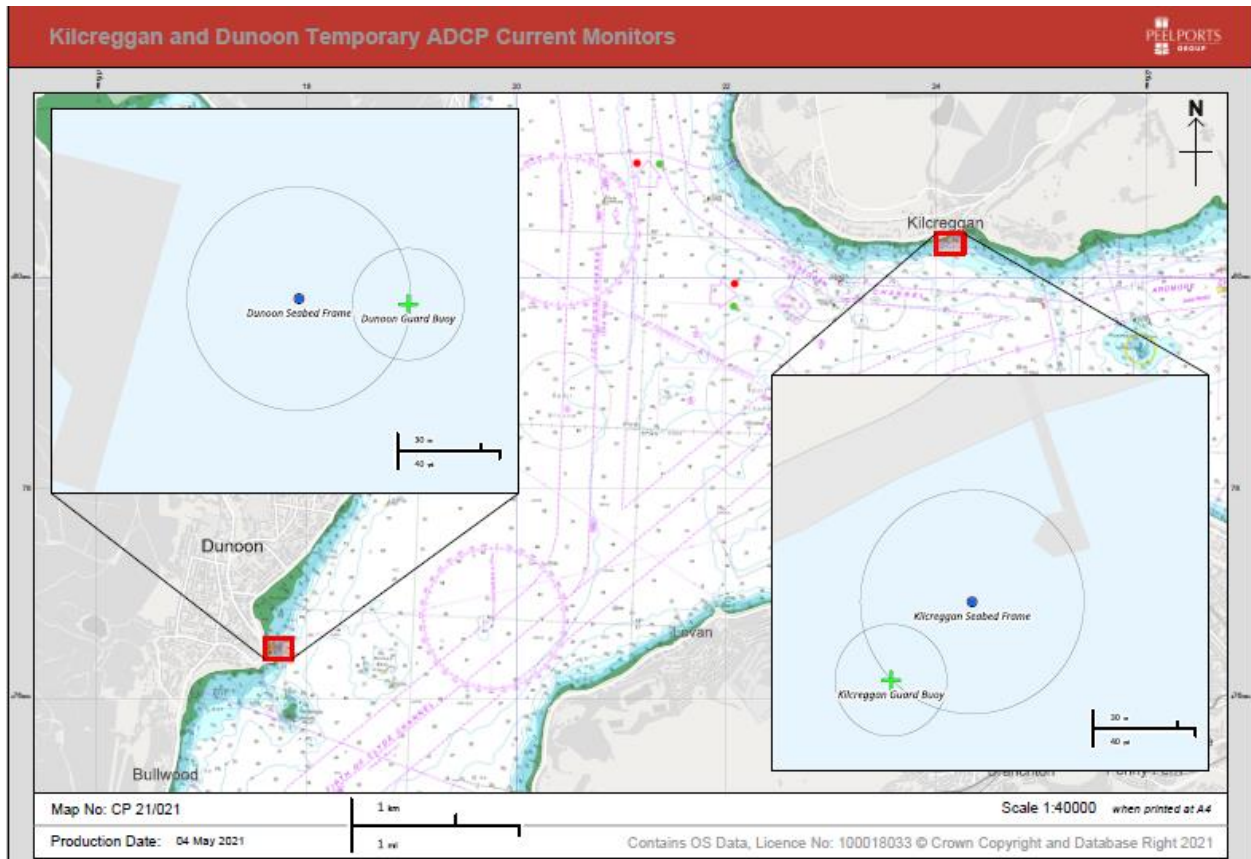
FIRTH OF CLYDE – DEPLOYMENT OF ACOUSTIC DOPPLER CURRENT PROFILER (ADCP) BY KILCREGGAN PIER AND DUNOON PIER

Mariners are advised that on Monday 24 May 2021, or thereabouts, two Acoustic Doppler Current Profilers (ADCPs) will be deployed for approximately 12 weeks by Kilcreggan Pier and Dunoon Pier as part of the work into developing the ferry terminals at these locations.

Kilcreggan Pier ADCP 55° 59' 01.7"N 004° 49' 13.3"W

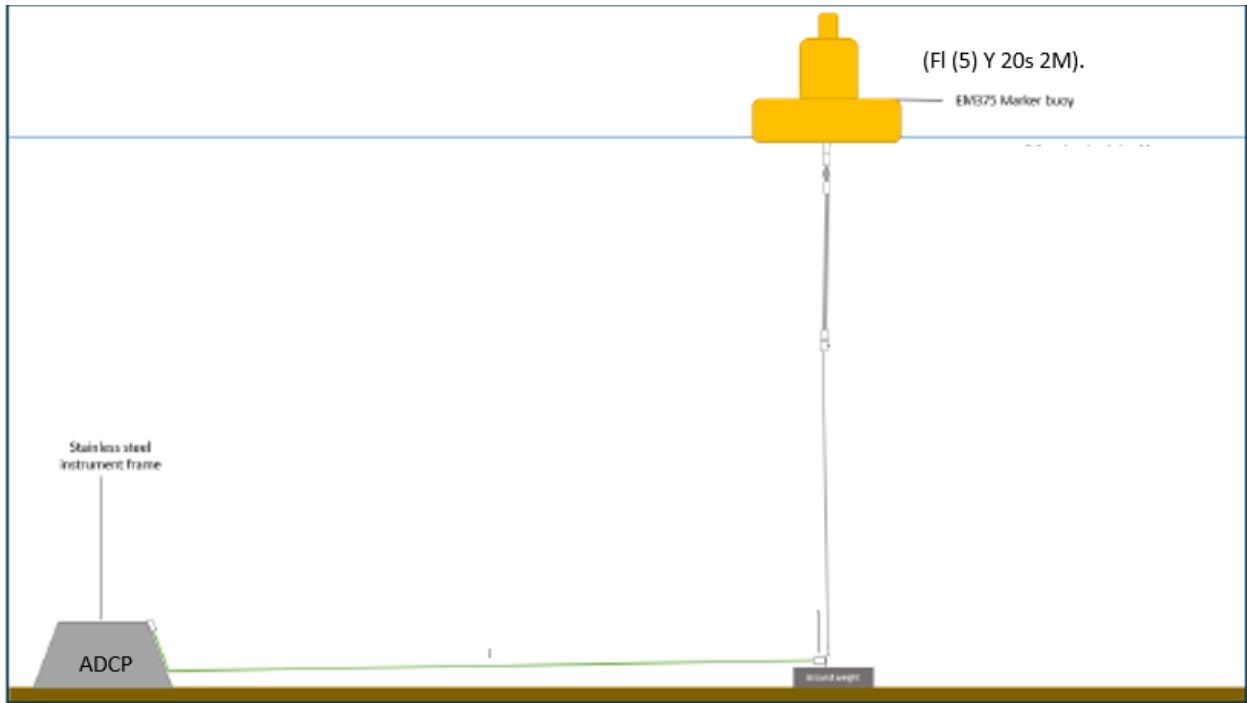
Dunoon Pier ADCP 55° 56' 48.1"N 004° 55' 13.3"W

The Workboat OSCAR or JULIA M will deploy, service and recover the ADCPs and their locations will be marked by a guard buoy: 1 metre diameter at the waterline and Yellow in colour, fitted with a radar reflector, yellow X topmark and a Yellow light, group flash 5 every 20 seconds, with a nominal range of 2 miles (Fl (5) Y 20s 2M).



Mariners are not to moor vessels on these temporary marker buoys or use them as Racing Marks.
