### **ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (GLENLOIN HOUSING SCHEME ROAD (THE SUCCOTH ACCESS ROAD), SUCCOTH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2018**

On Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2018, introduces a prohibition of waiting restriction on the Glenloin Housing Scheme Road, known as 'The Succoth Access Road' in Succoth, Arrochar.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 13<sup>th</sup> July 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
