ARGYLL AND BUTE COUNCIL (DUNBEG VILLAGE ROADS) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2018



On Monday 19th February 2018, Argyll and Bute Council made the above named Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

The Order, which comes into operation on Monday 9th April 2018, introduces a 20mph speed limit on all of Dunbeg Village Roads.

Modifications

The restriction on the length of No.92 (3) Dunbeg Village Roads, Jane Road has been reduced in length by 10 metres. This is to allow the signs to be situated in an appropriate location where they are clearly visible to drivers entering the village from the A85 Trunk Road. This is a change to the Order as originally proposed and advertised in the Oban Times on 18th January 2018.

Any person, who wishes to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the 23rd February 2018, apply to the Court of Session for this purpose.
